



Davao City, Philippines. The Regional Development Council XI conducted its roadshow activities for the Davao Region local government units starting off with the north cluster, comprising of Davao del Norte, Compostela Valley, Davao Oriental, in Nabunturan, Compostela Valley on January 26, 2018 followed by the south cluster, comprising of Davao del Sur, Davao City and Davao Occidental, on February 2, 2018 in Davao City. Local Chief Executives of Davao Region sealed its commitment to the region's development plan and implementation.

"It was with much optimism that we crafted the DRDP, 2017-2022 as our blueprint for development under the Administration. Series Duterte planning workshops and stakeholder consultations were conducted throughout the second half of 2016.
